# MIAMI METRO ZOO

## TROPICAL AMERICA EXHIBIT

Site Tech has completed the hardscape construction at the Tropical America Exhibit of the Miami Metro Zoo. The hardscape package, designed by Jones & Jones / EDAW, included stained concrete site and seat walls cast from custom form liners, concrete unit pavers, metal railings, precast concrete planters, and "Fractured Earth" integrally colored concrete paving with embossing skins, palm fronds, hand-seeded aggregates and custom tooling. The project was built by PCL Construction Services, Inc. ■



# RENAISSANCE FOUNTAIN

Site Tech recently completed construction of an elaborate Italian fountain and surrounding plaza at the Renaissance at Colony Park retail center in Ridgeland, MS. The fountain, which is reminiscent of one that might be found in a European square, has basin walls and tile, four ornate columns, two large bowls and four charging horses all hand carved in marble. An impressive 1,400 gallons per minute is pumped through 40 nozzles located around the basin wall. The fountain design was by Lee Richardson & Associates, LA, and the fountain equipment was designed and furnished by Roman Fountains. ■



# FONTAINEBLEAU RESORT

## RENOVATIONS COMPLETE

Site Tech has completed extensive renovations at the Fontainebleau Resort in Miami Beach. Designed by HKS Architects, Inc. and built by Turnberry Construction, the project features five architectural water features, travertine walls and columns, architectural colored stamped concrete, porcelain and glass tile, 30 cabana and trellis structures, and Ipe hardwood decking and railings. ■
